## Animals Helping People in Need

Would you and your pet like to be part of an exciting activity? One that is fun-filled, but most of all shares the remarkable love we have for our pets with people in need?

It's called **Animal Assisted Activity** and **Animal Assisted Therapy (AAAT)**, and you can become part of this exciting work!

Therapy animals are recognized for the love they share and the hope and assistance they bring to children and adults in rehabilitation centers, hospitals, and nursing homes. How can you do this?? Become a registered Pet Partner®.

The **Pet Partners®** program is a service of the Delta Society, a non-profit organization dedicated to improving human health through service and therapy animals. Through **Pet Partners®**, Delta Society trains volunteers, healthcare professionals, veterinarians, and a nationwide network of licensed instructors and animal evaluators to train and screen animals and handlers for volunteer service. **Pet Partners®** are person-animal teams who have been specially trained and evaluated to work in visiting animal programs.

### How can you become a registered Pet Partner®?

#### Step One: PT 101/102 – Pet Partners Team Training

The course is taught by a Delta Society Licensed Instructor and provides highly interactive hands-on training to teach you the skills required to do AAAT, how to work with special needs populations, basic skills needed to work in different facilities, monitoring your animal's behavior, preparation for the Pet Partner Team Evaluation, and the Delta policies and procedures. The class is broken down into two parts. The first part combines classroom training and one on one shadowing registered teams in a local hospital. The second part, in the afternoon, will provide more hands-on training as well as an understanding of the evaluation you will be required to take. We will give you training tips for the evaluation as well as to prepare you for the rewarding work in the Pet Partner Program.

#### Side Training note :

To move to the next step of the evaluation most people find it helps to attend an obedience course with their dog. This not only helps to create a stronger bond between the handler and dog but any bad habit either you or the dog may have can be corrected before the evaluation and will make your evaluation much more successful. There are many great places to take obedience courses. If you need help we will work with you to find one that is right for you.

#### Step Two: Pet Partners Team Evaluation –see additional brochure for evaluation information

You must attend the Pet Partners® Training course before Team evaluations. These evaluations show you and your pet's skill and aptitude to work as a Pet Partner® team. An appropriate team demonstrates reliability, controlability and predictability, works well together and inspires confidence in the people with whom they visit. Unlike agility and conformation, this is not about walking in front of a judge or winning the most points. It is about teamwork and how well you work together in difficult environments. It requires continuous interaction between the animal & handler, as well as with the people you are visiting. How you handle your dog and interact with your dog and the evaluators is the basis of the evaluation. **There are certain restrictions for children under 16 years of age, please contact us before sending in your registration.**

#### Register Today

The class size is restricted to 15. If the class is full when your registration is received you can opt to take the following class or a refund. If you and another person are to attend together both of you will be charged for the class. If less than 3 people register the class may be canceled. If this happens your money can be either refunded or you can be scheduled for the next class.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** If you need to cancel, you must notify me as soon as possible. I will either reschedule you for the next class or refund half of your class fee, whichever you prefer.
